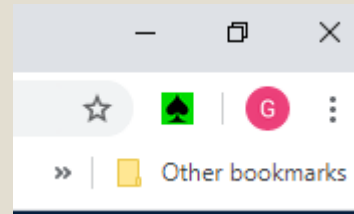

Playing through the 2NT by North contract

When the turn comes for each hand, the display will change to have subscripts under each of the cards. It will show the number of tricks you can get if you play this card. In this example, any card will result in 5 tricks.



Playing through the 2NT by North contract

East chose the 3 diamonds. For the next player (South) if either the A or K is played, this will result in 7 tricks whereas the 10 will give one extra trick i.e. 8 tricks.
